## SEAHO QUARTERLY REPORT ON RELI

The second annual RELI workshop was held at The University of Mississippi in Oxford, MS on June 1 – 3, 2005. Faculty conducting the institute were: Deb Boykin, William and Mary; Deb LoBiondo, Duke University; Shannon Staten, University of Louisville; Leon McClinton, Clemson; Gisela Vega, Florida International; Tim Coley, University of South Carolina; David Jones, University of Alabama; and Gary Kimble and Lorinda Krhut, University of Southern Mississippi.

Subjects covered were Dealing with Change, Problem Solving, Managing Multiple Priorities, Crises Management, Staff Selection, Supervision and Professional Development.
